We will eat a box lunch prior to taking a guided tour of the Legacy Center where we'll hear how solar power, geothermal, and sustainable building materials have helped this facility earn the rating of "greenest building in the world." We'll then tour Aldo Leopold's converted chicken shed and farm. We'll learn about the land ethic Leopold espoused and his legacy as the father of wildlife conservation.
