

12. Bay Shore Blufflands Nature Preserve 5454 Bay Shore Drive (County B) & 5519 Reynolds Road

Preserve Acres: 273 Miles of Hiking Trail: 2.5

Trail Rating: Easy-to-moderate with difficult, steep incline along bluff slope

Trail and Preserve Features: Lower trail passes through fields and young forest offering stunning views of the waters of Green Bay as it ascends the impressive, fern-filled talus slope of the Niagara Escarpment. The upper trail offers three loops through old fields on the top of the escarpment.

Bird's Eye View from the Escarpment...

This preserve was named for the rugged rock bluff of the Niagara Escarpment. The escarpment runs like a spine down the entire length of the preserve and provides breathtaking scenery, as well as a highly specialized habitat for many plants and animals. The open prairie attracts monarch butterflies, bumble bees, and bluebirds.
