- Balsam Fir (*Abies balsamea*)

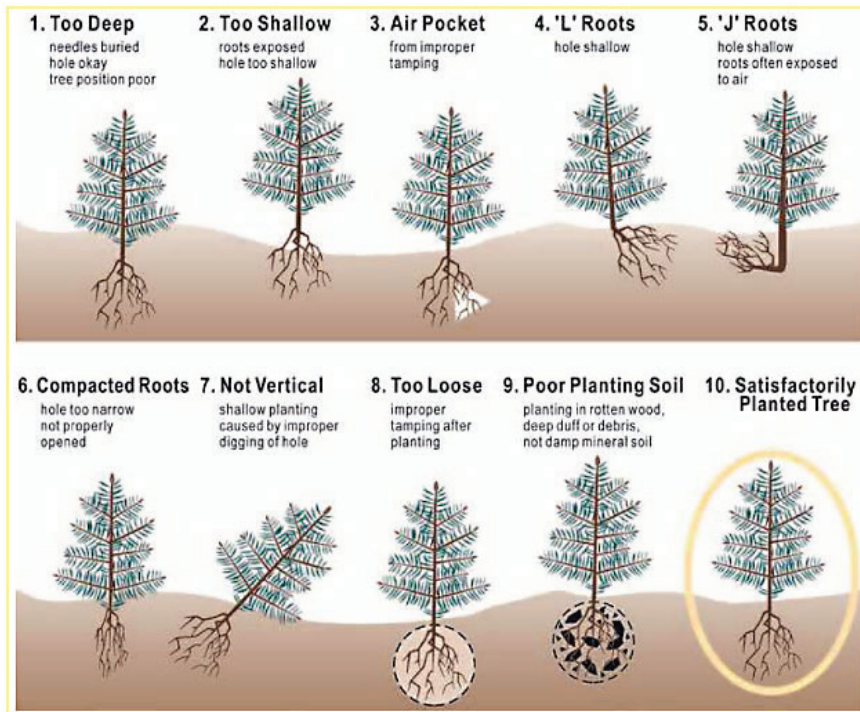

- Dogtooth Daisy, (*Helenium autumnale*)
- Prairie Blazing Star, (*Liatris pycnostachya*)
- Common ironweed, (*Vernonia fasciculata*)
- Blue/Woodland Phlox, (*Phlox divaricata*)

How to Plant Your Tree

1. Select a good location for your tree that will allow plenty of space for it to grow tall as well as wide.
2. Dig a hole 2" wider than the root ball and just as deep (about 3").
3. Identify the root flare (where the trunk expands at the base of the tree) and check for proper depth. The root ball should sit even with the surrounding soil. Ensure the hole is not too deep or too shallow.
4. Place the seedling into the hole, making sure it's straight, and begin to fill the hole with soil. Fill from the bottom of the hole to the top. Press down firmly so there are no air pockets or spaces around root ball.
5. Water your tree and watch it grow.
